## Sanctuary / Worship Space

### A. Does your worship space seem crowded at 80% capacity or higher?

- 1. No, we have ample room for growth.
- 2. No, it seems about right for most Sundays but tight on special occasions.
- 3. Yes, most Sundays are full.

## B. Is it hard to see and/or hear from the last row of seats even after rearranging seating or upgrading / adding equipment?

- 1. No, there is no impairment to sound or vision.
- 2. At times this can be an issue.
- 3. Yes, this is a problem.

#### C. Do you have adequate lighting in the worship space and can it be adjusted for different functions?

- 1. Yes, we have adequate lighting that can be adjusted to dim or spot.
- 2. Yes, lighting is adequate for our worship space but does not have the ability to be adjusted.
- 3. No, our lighting is not sufficient for the needs of our church.



## D. Will your existing worship space accommodate special events such as concerts, plays, weddings, conferences, baptisms, funerals, etc?

- 1. Yes, with minimal to no crowding.
- 2. Yes, sometimes we have to add chairs or people have to stand.
- 3. No, we have inadequate space/facilities.

#### E. Does your platform or stage seem crowded?

- 1. No, we have plenty of room for growth with our choir and/or worship team and it is large enough to serve other functions.
- 2. No, it is only crowded if we add more people than normal or additional instruments; and there is limited space for other functions.
- 3. Yes, the stage area is too small and has extreme functional limitations.

#### F. Do you have a cry room available for nursing mothers?

- 1. Yes, it is close to the worship center and equipped with sound and vision by some means, such as a TV monitor.
- 2. Yes, it is located away from the worship center and it is not accessible to vision or sound.

## Classrooms / Educational Areas

## H. Do you have enough classrooms or divided areas to accommodate your Sunday school classes or Bible Studies?

- 2. Yes, all our classrooms are presently being used but we have flexibility to change age group distribution to handle future growth.

### I. Is your Nursery large and updated enough to meet the needs of your congregation?

- 2. It would meet the needs of our church if minor improvements were made.

### J. Would your classrooms accommodate future outreach programs that the church has plans for?

- 2. No, it is not a priority since we have no plans for any new programs in the future.
- 3. No, our current facility has no space for implementation of any additional programs outside of our Sunday and midweek service.

## **Score: Classroom / Education Facility**

## **Foyer / Restroom Facility**

#### L. Do you have room for an information desk, comfortable seating and coat storage in your foyer?

- 2. Yes, there is adequate floor space for additional equipment but would need some remodeling to add electrical outlets and storage space.
- 3. No, the kitchen would not accommodate any future ministry growth or we have no kitchen.

#### P. Does your fellowship hall seem too small or crowded to serve the daily needs of your church?

- 1. No, our fellowship hall has adequate room to facilitate the needs of our church.
- 2. We have no fellowship hall.
- 3. Yes, our church has outgrown using the fellowship hall for the purposes it was originally designed for.

## Q. Is your fellowship hall large enough to provide adequate accommodations for special events such as wedding receptions, special dinners, prayer breakfasts, fellowship luncheons, etc.?

- 1. Yes, our fellowship hall is currently being used in this capacity with room for expansion.
- 2. Yes, there is adequate floor space for additional equipment but would need some remodeling to add electrical outlets and storage space.
- 3. No, the fellowship hall would not accommodate any future ministry growth.



### **Score: Kitchen / Fellowship Hall**
